Last year 150 soldiers from the **Texas State Guard** participated, however many more would have attended if the breakfast had been fully sponsored.

The **Texas State Guard** is comprised of over 2,000 volunteer Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen and Marines who are on call at a moment's notice at the discretion of the Governor of Texas. Our mission: to assist in disasters and help the hurting. Our selfless men and women purchase all their uniforms and equipment with their own money. They also drill once a month at the Army National Guard Armories all across this **GREAT State of Texas** at no pay or cost to the tax payers of Texas.

**We are looking to raise \$5,000 by May 15th.**

Each meal ticket costs \$12 and we would like to have our troops attend without cost to them.
